A possible grand slam — on limited values — can be a theory problem at duplicate, as the right decision depends on guessing the content at other tables. Here the majority may stop, not unreasonably, at six spades. Some will reach six no-trumps — much inferior, both to seven spades and six.

Seven spades is a reasonable contract because it nearly always comes home when trumps are 5-2 and still has chances when they are not. A sophisticated sequence would be:

Six hearts — the suit below the agreed trump suit — is a trump asking bid, to locate the queen of spades.

Despite the trump break, seven spades play quite well: cast the trump ace, lead low to the queen, noting the singleton; ruff a club and pick up the trumps; develop the hearts in approved fashion and claim thirteen tricks.

Easy — unless North has the presence of mind to contribute the nine of spades on the first round — in that case East may decide to continue with the king!

This time it's the turn EW to reach an obvious game contract, the likely sequence being:

| South | West | North    | East |
|-------|------|----------|------|

On the surface, line tricks are delightfully easy. A spade is led and East proceeds to lay down the K-Q of clubs. Observing the singleton, he takes the proven finesse and eventually settles for contract when North declines to throw too many diamonds away as the clubs are run off. But — as we saw on Board 13 — if South knows his business, it's not so simple. When the first club is cashed, South drops the nine, offering East the capability of guarding against four clubs in the North hand.

Even if East knows that South is capable of this clever deceptive play, he can easily go wrong. Mathematically, South, rather than North, is more likely to be short of clubs, as he is presumed to have length in spades.

On the second round of the suit, East may decide to lead low to the ace. In that case, all he can do is to go down with a good grace and compliment his opponent.

No-one should have much trouble reaching four hearts, a popular route being this:

| South | West | North | East     |
|-------|------|-------|----------|
| 1♦    | pass | 1♥    | pass     |
| 2♥    | pass | 4♥    | All pass |

To score well, declarer must aim to make a lot of tricks. A crossruff has obvious attractions: North discards a couple of spades on dummy's diamonds and proceeds to ruff clubs and spades alternately. This works out pretty well and brings in an easy, if unspectacular, eleven tricks.

Can North do better? Well, either by accident or design, he may succeed in making all four of dummy's trumps, as well as two trumps and the ace of trumps in his own hand. That means 680.

This feat is achieved via a coup en passant, one of the most satisfying plays in the book. Declarer's last three cards are A-10 or trumps and a club. When the club is led, East, with K-x of trumps, cannot prevent dummy's singleton queen of trumps from making a trick. To reach this ending, declarer should aim to ruff clubs right from the start.

Hvor det danske vinderpar, Otto Hermansen/Franziska Heilsted, sad Nord-Syd, gik meldingerne:

Øst startede med klør til esset over damen, og efter ØK gik Hermansen på bordet via en klørtrumfning og lagde to spar på Ø-Ø. Efter ØE fulgte en veritabel krydstlumfning: spar til trumf, klør til trumf, spar til trumf, klør til trumf. Nu var stillingen:

Hier fortsatte Otto Hermansen med den sidste spar til ØE, hvorpå klør mod bordet sikrede det tolvte stik på ØD! Resultatet gav Nord-Syd en score på 84 af 100 mulige.
